What is a callback?,

A call back is an invitation for a second audition. A callback means the director wants to see how you do in a specific role as well as how you may fit in the cast overall. If you do not receive a callback, it does not mean that you will not be cast. It just means the director does not need to see you in a second audition.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Rehearsals:	Rehearsals will begin on Thursday ,January 9th at 10:00am. Actors should be prepared to rehearse on every date on the calendar. All known conflicts must be listed below and cleared with the Director. Should a conflict arise, please email/text Mrs. Denton directly as soon as you know.
Tech Week:	March 27th – April 1st (All cast and crew are expected to be present for each rehearsal.)
Crew Calls:	During some rehearsals, all actors will be required to contribute to the creation of this production through helping in set construction, costuming, lighting, etc.
Performances:	April 2-5, 2025 (4/2-3 Daytime School Shows, 4/4-5 Evening Shows)

Remember, when you audition for a show at BCVS, you are auditioning for every role. It is the Directorial Team's job to cast you or not cast you as they see fit.

If you drop out of the show after you have been cast, you will NOT be eligible to audition for another show at BCVS for that school year. Do not damage your reputation by dropping out of a production without a valid reason.

You may be asked to furnish your own costume or parts of your costume. The budget does not always allow the luxury of designing costumes for each character. Additionally, if and when costumes are provided for you, you must take care not to damage your costumes. Any rented or borrowed costume or costume piece for which BCVS is charged "excessive wear" and/or replacement fees, the student will be expected to cover that cost. Please take care of all the garments you are issued for the production.

Academic Expectation: Throughout the rehearsal process, you are expected to maintain your grades in all of your classes. I understand that the nature of the virtual school allows for you to make up missed assignments and that pacing zeroes can drop your grades quickly. Mrs. Denton will be monitoring grades throughout and if you fall below passing in your classes (whether or not you are on PASS), you will be expected to come to campus for required amounts of time to make sure that you are completing your work.

You must have passing grades in order to attend rehearsals or performances.

- Please note that auditions are closed to anyone except the individuals auditioning.
- WHAT TO PREPARE:
 - **Prepare one of the given monologues:** Pick a monologue and go to town! Show us the level of fun you're willing to have with your character!
 - Prepare part of a song: Prepare 16-32 bars of any musical theater song *in the style of the show*. The selection should <u>not exceed 1 minute</u>. Sing something that showcases you and your talent and range.
 - **Bring accompaniment:** Bring an accompaniment track on your phone to connect to our bluetooth speaker. No acapella auditions, please.
 - **Prepare "Let Me Drive the Bus:"** The sheet music/lyrics are provided in the packet, and the track can be found on the Pelican Players' Schoology Page or the Pelican Players' page on the school website (under Organizations).
 - Please slate as you begin. "Hello, my name is _____, and today I'll be singing _____."
 - Focus on acting/connecting/expression! Perform for us like you're performing in your living room for your cat/dog/hamster/etc. Perfection is not expected – we're hoping to see your potential!
 - **Casting timeline:** After callbacks have been completed, the cast list will be posted within a few days.
